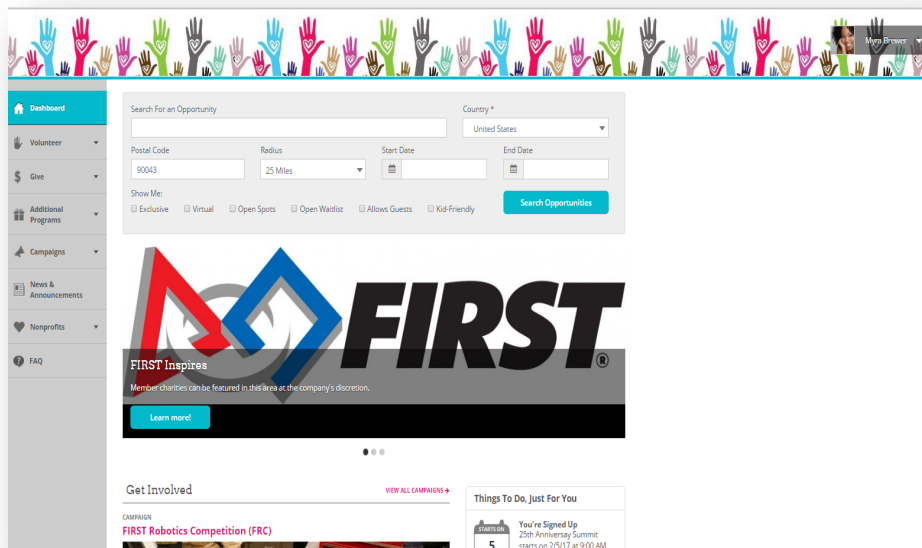

Below are some of the many ways that your nonprofit may be featured and promoted through the America's Charities powered by Causecast online giving solution.¹

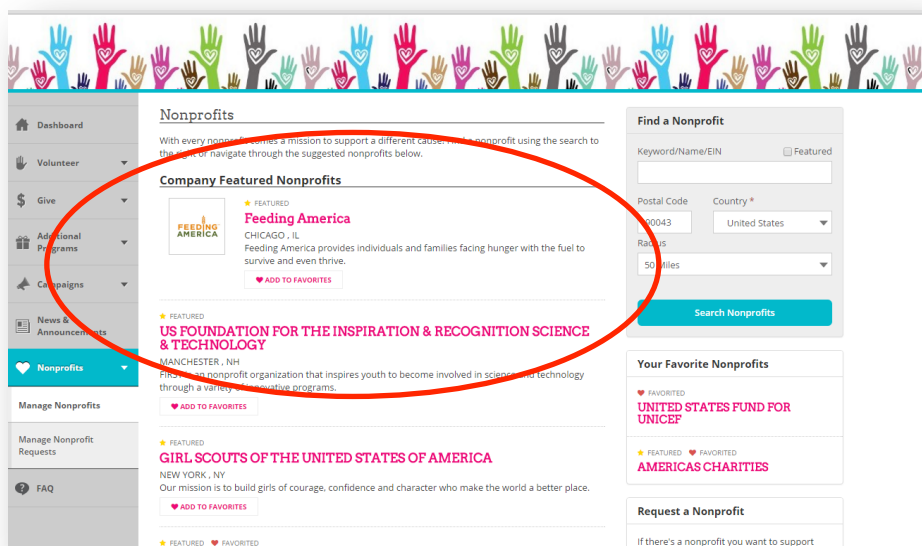
Highlighted/Promoted on Dashboard Page:

On the **Dashboard** page that employees see first once they have logged into the platform, employers can feature specific opportunities to support your charity through a call-to-action banner as shown here:



“Featured” Nonprofit:

Employers can draw special attention to charities like yours by designating your charity as a **Featured Nonprofit** in the Nonprofit section of the platform, which ensures your charity is listed where donors go to search for causes to support:

Campaigns, “Adopt-a-Campaign” and Cause Funds:

Campaigns are programs that employers run to generate internal employee support for nonprofits. Companies can create their own campaigns from scratch, using content they have on hand or content from America's Charities' Client Resource Center where we share member success stories, videos and other material our nonprofit members have provided for employer use (this information is collected when the member submits their membership application).

Employers can also view uploaded campaigns in the Campaign Library in the platform where they can **Adopt-a-Campaign** from multiple options that have been created by America's Charities. **Cause Fund** campaigns created by America's Charities feature our nonprofit members based on specific cause areas.



Ways for Your Nonprofit May be Featured

Fundraiser Campaigns & Crowdfunding:

Companies use **Fundraiser Campaigns** in the platform to rally employees behind a specific charity, and to empower those employees to solicit support for that charity from their friends and family outside the workplace. One type of fundraising is **Crowdfunding**, which involves a more specific request: the crowd is solicited for financial contributions to a particular project or cause.

FIRST Helps Students Excel in Science
A big advantage to participating in FIRST is gaining access to millions in college scholarships made available by colleges, universities, and corporations who support FIRST. This is an exclusive pool of financial help open only to FIRST team members, giving them a competitive leg up on other students seeking educational funds.
Most are for use at the specific Provider college or university, but some can be used at any school. About 40% of FIRST Scholarships can be used for any course of study, not just engineering. Amounts vary from one-time awards to full four-year tuition.


